This is an arithmetic sequence with common difference of 4. The first element is 2, and total elements are 12. So, $a_1 = 1$, d = 3 and n = 12. So, by using the formula of nth term of an arithmetic sequence, first we will find the 12th term

$$a_n = a_1 + (n-1)d$$

= 2 + (12 - 1)4
= 2 + (11)4
= 46

Now, by using the formula for the sum of n elements of an arithmetic sequence, we have

$$S_n = \frac{n}{2} (a_1 + a_n)$$

$$= \frac{12}{2} (2 + 46)$$

$$= 6(48)$$

$$= 288$$

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
